Pebbell+ powered by tap2tag® is a mobile pendant alarm - a two-way communication device connecting a potentially vulnerable person with someone who can help in an emergency or difficult situation.

It's the only mobile pendant alarm in the world powered by tap2tag®, meaning it's also equipped with NFC (near-field communication) technology. This gives first-responders and paramedics access to vital personal medical information such as known conditions, prescribed drugs and life-saving interventions.



How does the device work?

It's a small, discreet aid, about the size of an egg. A typical user wears the device around their neck or attached to a belt. although it can be carried in a pocket.

It's very simple to use, yet has incredibly advanced features and capabilities.

Fully waterproof: stay safe, even in the shower!









Two-way communication: or one-way in an emergency

At its most simple, it's a tiny mobile phone with a SIM card, microphone and speaker, which users and their carers or loved ones can use to communicate.

In a difficult situation or an emergency, however, it becomes a potentially life-saving device. If the wearer is in difficulty, they simply press a button to summon help. If they have a fall, the device detects the sudden drop, through an inbuilt accelerometer, and alerts emergency contacts. You can pre-programme up to

three emergency contacts into

the device. In the event of activation or a fall, the device sends a text message (SMS) to each contact giving:

- details of the device owner (eg. 'Mum', 'Dad', 'Joan')
- date and time of activation
- a link to Google Maps™ identifying the exact location of the user
- 'fall alert' if appropriate
- current battery life of the device

The device also telephones the first-named contact. If the call is not answered it calls other contacts. If the patient is conscious they can speak to the emergency contact.

Wander alert!

Pebbell+ powered by tap2tag® is also equipped with the latest 'geo-fencing' software. This is a powerful feature, extremely helpful in preventing vulnerable people from wandering beyond where they are safe, such as their home and garden or the boundaries of a care home.

You can specify the area outside of which the alert activates, for example beyond 50 metres of their home. If the 'wander' alert is activated the text messages also give the exact location of the wearer. At any time, a carer or loved one can text a code to the device and it will return information on their whereabouts.

Life-saving information on tap: the only pendant alarm embedded with tap2tag®

Your device also includes all the benefits of tap2tag® Medical. You can upload vital medical information to your Pebbell+ which becomes immediately

accessible to first-responders, family or passers-by in the case of an emergency.

You choose the data you wish to share. Typical users include:

- · their name
- known medical conditions
- any and all medications they need
- any message, for example

"Call 999. I have a heart condition. Spray is in my bag. Spray once in my mouth then wait for paramedics."

A user might also choose to include information on organ donation, their date of birth, blood group and a photograph.

No data is stored on the device. You upload the information online on a very secure, password-protected portal, and you can update it at any time. It's a great way of keeping track of medications!

How do first-responders access the information?

Every tap2tag® device is embedded with ultra-modern 'NFC' technology (near-field communication). It is used through a mobile phone. In an emergency, for example if the wearer collapses, after calling the emergency services anyone with an NFC-enabled mobile phone can 'tap' the device. With a couple of clicks they can gain instant access to the vital information. Even if the first-responder hasn't activated the tap2tag® Medical information, the paramedics can do so on arrival. gaining potentially life-saving information about the patient.

All modern phones have NFC, but in the unlikely event that the first on the scene doesn't have NFC they can access the information using any internetenabled device, including their mobile phone.

In the meantime, of course, the three contacts pre-programmed into the device have received text messages and phone calls alerting them to the incident.
